March 26, 2021

Below is the current status of the bills we are tracking. Priority bills are highlighted in yellow. Clicking on the bill number will launch the state legislative website where the full text of the legislation and additional information can be found.

The number of bills we're tracking still stands at 15. There was no action on any of your priority bills this week. The next deadline is April 8th, which is when all bills must be out of committee in the opposite chamber.

We'll continue to update this as the session moves along and keep you apprised of any new developments.
